CONFERENCE COST

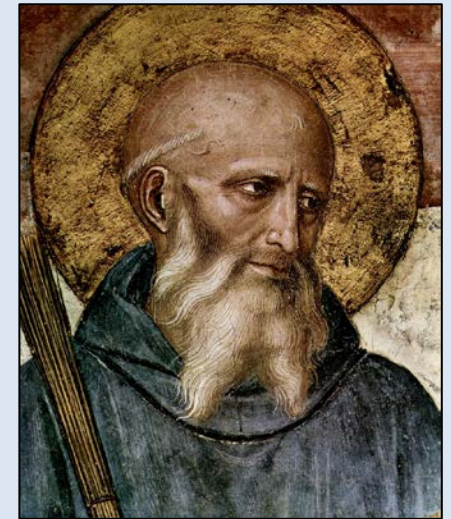
